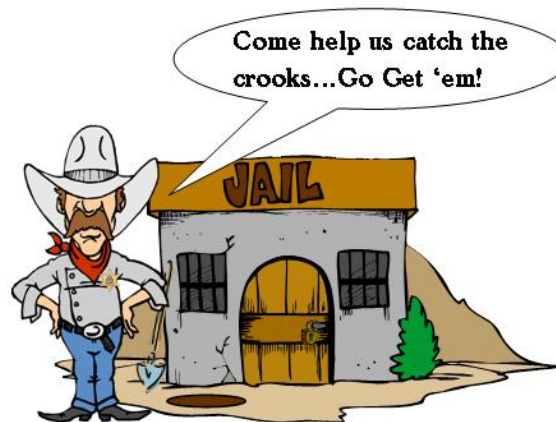

## RACE INFORMATION:

This is a 5K (3.1 miles) loop course, starting and ending at the Franklin County Sheriff's Office, located at 160 Elm Street in Greenfield, MA. The first mile of the course is slightly downhill to the beginning of the bicycle path. The next mile follows the bicycle path along the river and behind the jail. The end of the path marks the second mile marker, where you face a hill, and then a flat run back to the jail to the finish line. USATF sanctioned event timing provided by ACCU-SPEC.

Registration opens at 8:00 AM for Runners and Walkers. Race start time is 10:00 AM.

The Kids Fun Run (1/2 mile course) begins at 9:30 AM and is free. Registration is the day of the race.

Can you catch the "crooks"? Before the start of the race, there will be three "crooks" who will get a head start. Pass all three and cross the finish line before them and you will receive a special award.

A cash prize will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> male and 1<sup>st</sup> female finisher.

## DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

### ***From the north or south:***

On Interstate 91, take exit 26. From the north, at the end of the exit ramp, merge into the rotary. Take the third exit off the rotary onto Route 2A East. Coming from the south, take the first exit off the rotary onto Route 2A East. Pass through two sets of traffic lights, and take next left onto Solon Street. Continue straight on Solon Street which turns into Elm Street. The Franklin County Jail and House of Correction is 1/2 mile on left.

### ***From the east:***

From Route 2 Westbound, take Routes 5 & 10 – Greenfield exit. At end of exit ramp, take left onto Routes 5 & 10 (Federal Street). At first set of lights, take right onto Silver Street. Follow Silver Street to end. Take left at end of Silver Street (Leyden Road). 1/10 of a mile take a right at fork onto Elm Street. The Franklin County Jail and House of Correction is 1/2 mile on right.

### ***From the west:***

Follow Route 2 and enter rotary at Route 91 Interchange. Take second exit off the rotary onto Route 2A East. Pass through two sets of traffic lights, and take next left onto Solon Street. Continue straight on Solon Street which turns into Elm Street. The Franklin County Jail and House of Correction is 1/2 mile on left.
